Pastor Ninabeth: The God of all grace, who has called us to eternal glory in Christ establish you and strengthen you by the power of the Holy Spirit, that you may live in grace and peace.

AFFIRMATION From 1 Corinthians 12, Jn. 3. 5-6

Left side: No one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit.

Right side: Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.

Men: There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit in all people. To each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

Women: The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. We were all baptized by one Spirit into one body, and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

All: We are the body of Christ, and each one of us is a part of it.

Right side : God says: "Here is my servant community whom I have chosen, the ones I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on them, and they will proclaim justice to the nations."

Left side: The Spirit of the Holy One is upon us, for God has anointed us to preach good news to the poor. God has sent us to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the grace of God.

All: Alleluia! Holy Spirit, be in us the light of God for the world. Alleluia!

PRAYER OF GOD'S PEOPLE

Leader: Let us pray for all who suffer as a result of conflict, and ask that God may give us peace:

All: for the service men and women who have died in the violence of war, each one remembered by and known to God; may God give peace.

For those who love them in death as in life, offering the distress of our grief and the sadness of our loss; may God give peace.

For all members of the armed forces who are in danger this day, remembering family, friends and all who pray for their safe return; may God give peace.

For civilian women, children and men whose lives are disfigured by war or terror, calling to mind in penitence the anger and hatreds of humanity; may God give peace.

For peacemakers and peacekeepers, who seek to keep this world secure and free; may God give peace.

For all who bear the burden and privilege of leadership, political, military and religious; asking for gifts of wisdom and resolve in the search for reconciliation and peace; may God give peace.

O God of truth and justice, we hold before you those whose memory we cherish,

and those whose names we will never know. Help us to lift our eyes above the torment of this broken world, and grant us the grace to pray for those who wish us harm.

As we honour the past, may we put our faith in your future; for you are the source of life and hope, now and for ever. Amen.
