THE BASKET Blessing of the Animals

A PRAYER FOR THE BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS

God of love and beauty, you have fashioned every creature with your hands.

You look upon every creature with your eyes. You hold every creature in your heart.

So we pray for the creatures you have given us. We give thanks for animals that give us companionship. We give thanks for animals that help and serve. We ask your blessing for animals we love. We pray for good health and happy life for them.

May their presence comfort us, their loyalty reassure us.

May the playfulness of puppies and the songs of birds remind us always of your grace.

May all their differences of fur and feather, great and small, remind us that you love us all. In our care for them may we reflect your care for us. God of all living, in all our different voices, with barks and yips and purrs and chirps, and with silence, too, we praise you, we ask your blessing, and we trust your grace. Amen.

SCRIPTURE Matthew 10:1-14 Common English Bible

He called his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to throw them out and to heal every disease and every sickness. Here are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon, who is called Peter; and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee; and John his brother; Philip; and Bartholomew; Thomas; and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus; and Thaddaeus; Simon the Cananaean; and Judas, who betrayed Jesus.

Jesus sent these twelve out and commanded them, "Don't go among the Gentiles or into a Samaritan city. Go instead to the lost sheep, the people of Israel. As you go, make this announcement: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with skin diseases, and throw out demons. You received without having to pay. Therefore, give without demanding payment. Workers deserve to be fed, so don't gather gold or silver or copper coins for your money belts to take on your trips. Don't take a backpack for the road or two shirts or sandals or a walking stick. Whatever city or village you go into, find somebody in it who is worthy and stay there until you go on your way. When you go into a house, say, 'Peace!' If the house is worthy, give it your blessing of peace. But if the house isn't worthy, take back your blessing. If anyone refuses to welcome you or listen to your words, shake the dust off your feet as you leave that house or city.
